b. Program Update: Summer & Fall
 September calendar prepared by Samantha Charette, Recreation Lead, to let parents
 and others know what is going on in the department.
 It was a good summer although it was rainier than usual. Campers were moved to
 the Town hall Annex and/or Scout Hall on rainy stormy days.

c. CIP Submissions

5 year look out – a wish list of projects over \$20,000 thresh hold wants. The director stated that she is trying to be proactive, rather than reactive when something breaks. This summer the interns did inventory of all amenities in the all the parks. The following is a list of the submissions.

- Park Amenities phase in a plan to replace existing charcoal grills and picnic tables at all town parks
- Shade structure replace gazebos at Volunteer Park due to age as well as install new shade structures at east Windsor Park. Also replace gazebo at Broad Brook Pond Park
- Skate Park Equipment Complete purchasing and installation of equipment at the EW BMX/Skate Park. This has been an on-going volunteer-based project for over 10 years. Fund raising effort garner small gains and are not able to complete the project in a timely manner.
- Concrete Pads Provide more permanent shade structures at East Windsor Park and Volunteer Park. Concrete pads are needed for anchoring and less maintenance under them.
- Basketball Court Repairs Repair the basketball court at East Windsor Park, new hoops at Osborn Park, and repair the basketball court at Prospect Hill Park. Priority is for Prospect Hill, so we don't need to do a full reconstruction. Nonadjustable models would be used. Commissioner Szymanski asked if there was a way to lock the adjustable model. The Director stated they will cut off the locks and misuse the hoops.
- Playground upgrades/replacements replace play equipment that was removed 4 years ago due to age and disrepair. Allows for families in walking distance of this pocket park to have an option for play.

- Work is being done on the ADA compliant playground at East Windsor Park —
 The weather has slowed the contractor who is finishing another project in town
- There are paperwork issues at the state level with the lighting for Abbe Road, hopefully it will start next Monday.
- The shade structures going over the player benches are built and ready to be installed as soon as the concrete pads are poured. It is important to secure the structures.
- Kick off weekend for East Windsor Soccer
- Partnership with CT Titans baseball using the field at Osborn
- Will begin to winterize the parks. East Windsor Park is closed for the winter but people can still come and use the park at no cost
- Partnered with Kakley fitness for a 5K road race on October 14, 2023
- More community partners are using the park.
- Scare Crow Contest theme this year will be East Windsor Strong
- The Haunted Highway will be October 26, 2023. The community comes out and showcases their organization in a friendly competition for best booth.
- Afterschool programs will be beginning and will include Home Alone Safety, CPR Certification, Babysitting, Heartsafe designation renewal
