

Email Blast: Don't be left out in the cold. Sign up for the email blast and be notified of all the latest East Windsor Parks & Recreation Programs that are being offered. Simply sign up on www.eastwindsor-ct.gov. Go to the home page and scroll to the bottom and on the bottom right is a link for Email Subscriber. Complete the required information and submit the request.



Program Information: The East Windsor Parks and Recreation Department has the right to cancel, reschedule or relocate a program or event according to facility availability and public participation. We may also enforce a minimum and/or maximum number of participants needed to make a program viable. Our programs are self-funding which means in order for them to run we need to get the enrollment that is necessary. *Please don't wait until the last minute to sign up. These programs are for you and your children and cannot be held without participation. Sign up Today!!!* Thank you for your support.



Registration Process: The East Windsor Parks and Recreation Department accepts registrations on an in-person basis during posted office hours. We also accept registrations through the mail-in process and have drop boxes located at all East Windsor Town Buildings and Schools. You can also register online via our Webster Bank Payment link; cost of the programs is taken from your designated checking account and registration is passed on to the Parks and Recreation Office. Programs are on a first-come/first-serve basis, and we must obtain enough registrations to make the program successful. Non-residents can register for our programs; special fees will be posted on a class-by-class basis.



Payment/Refund Policies: Payment must be paid in full at the time of registration unless otherwise stated in the program information. We accept cash and checks payable to "East Windsor Parks and Recreation." Returned checks will be charged a \$20 fee. Payment is also available through our online Webster Bank Payment link; program cost is deducted from your designated checking account. You DO NOT have to be a Webster account holder to use this service.

After a program begins NO REFUNDS will be given unless extenuating circumstances prevents you from participating in the program. The cost of trips is also non-refundable.

The rink is available after school hours during the week, and during the evening as well.




