MLS Summer Soccer Camp: The East Windsor Parks and Recreation Department is sponsoring a youth soccer camp at a location at East Windsor High School. Instructors will be staff from the MLS organization. Fee for this program is \$75. Camp will run from August 9th to August 13th (Mon-Fri.) from 5p.m. to 8 p.m. and is open to both residents and nonresidents. Camp is for athletes in grades 4 to 9.

Counselor In Training Program: This program is for young adults ages 13-15 interested in working with children for the summer with the intent to become a camp counselor in the future. Each C.I.T will take part in daily camp duties and assist campers and counselors. Submit the registration form, along with the C.I.T. Application, to the Parks and Recreation Office by May 17, 2010. The C.I.T Program is a 7 week program, beginning July 6th. Each session will have a limit of 6 C.I.T. participants. Cost Per Week: \$50 Residents/\$60 Non-Residents. A \$10 non-refundable deposit/week required at sign-up. Weekly balance due at time of attendance. Summer Fun in the Park: Summer Fun in the Park summer camp is back for children ages 6-12! Camp will be held Monday through Thursday at the East Windsor Park. Sessions are 4 days each week and will include a different theme every week. Field Trips will be taken once per session and will cost between \$6 and \$10 per child. 2010 Camp T-shirt will be sold for \$8.00 and **must be** worn on all field trips. Please indicate child's size on registration form. Registration will close **TWO WEEKS** before each session. Camp registrations will be accepted starting May 1st for East Windsor Residents. Non-residents can register starting May 10th. **NO Phone Registrations will be accepted. First session of Camp will be July 6-8. (Camp is only 3 days due to 4th of July holiday and will be discounted by \$10 per child.)**

Hours/Fees: 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.: \$75/week first child, \$70/week each additional child. **Non-residents add \$10 per week.**

7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.: \$85/week first child, \$80/week each additional child. **Non-residents add \$10 per week.**

Upon registration, a **NON-Refundable \$10.00** deposit per child is required to reserve your spot per session. Balance must be paid before the first day of each session otherwise Camper will NOT be allowed at Camp. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!! Space is Limited!!**



Tiny Tots Summer Fun: Tiny Tots summer fun is back for children ages 4 & 5. Camp will be held at East Windsor Park, Monday through Thursday. Half Day Campers do not go swimming, but will use the sprinkler on a daily basis. Field Trips are not available to Tiny Tots, but special interest events will be brought to the camp. **First session of Camp will be July 6-8. (Camp is only 3 days due to 4th of July holiday and will be discounted by \$10 per child.)**

Fees: Half-Day Camp: 9 a.m. to Noon: \$60/week first child, \$55/week each additional child. Full-Day Camp is the same as Summer Fun Camp. **Non-residents add \$10 per week. Space is Limited to 10 campers per session.** T-shirts are available for \$8 but are not required to attend camp.
