9/11 World Trade Center Memorial Radio City Christmas Spectacular

The **National September 11 Memorial** is a tribute of remembrance and honor to the nearly 3,000 people killed in the terror attacks on September 11, 2001 and the six people killed in the bombing in February 1993.

The Memorial's twin reflecting pools are each nearly an acre in size and feature the largest manmade waterfalls in North America and sit within the footprints of where the Twin Towers once stood. The names of every person who died in the 2001 and 1993 attacks are inscribed on bronze panels around the edges of the memorial pools, this being the reminder of the largest loss of life resulting from a foreign attack on American soil.

After, stop at **Eataly**, a 50,000 square foot space which features multiple restaurants, a microbrewery, a Neopolitan Pizzeria, a year-round rooftop beer garden, not to mention a cooking school and retail sections offering everything from Italian housewares to Prosiutto di Parma. This is a multimillion dollar project dreamed up by culinary favorites Mario Batali, Joe Bastianich, and Lidia Matticchio Bastianich. Spend the time shopping and poking around in all of the wonderfully amazing stores this complex has to offer.

This afternoon you will be at the **Radio City Music Hall**, where you have reserved orchestra seats to see the all new Christmas Spectacular! If you have never seen the show you are in for a great surprise, and if you have, you have never seen it like this. Using 'christmasvision' and digital technology the interior of Radio City transforms into a massive and magical canvas.
