





SPECIAL TOWN MEETING


The legal voters of the Town of East Windsor are hereby warned that a special town meeting will be held at the Town Hall, 11 Rye Street, Broad Brook, CT on Tuesday, November 1, 2011 at 7:30 p.m. for the following:


1. To approve the transfer of \$2,877.00 from Road Improvements (3183/0600) to CNR-Road Improvements (08/1025/0484) in the 2010/2011 budget.
2. To approve the transfer of \$520.00 from P. Safety/Employee Benefits-Pension Plan (2195/203) to the Fire Dept-FD Incentive Program (2150/230) in the 2010/2011 budget.
3. To adopt an ordinance entitled "Right to Farm Ordinance".
4. To consider and vote upon (1) an appropriation of \$850,000 for the cost of the North Sewer Project, Phase II including, but not limited to, the construction of sanitary sewer lines to extend sewer service along North Road from Mullen Road and continuing approximately 1500-2500 feet, and all alterations, repairs and improvements in connection therewith, as well as engineering, architectural and temporary and permanent financing costs, and to meet said appropriation, and in lieu of a tax therefore, the issuance and sale of bonds and notes of the Town pursuant to Chapter 109 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, the Town Charter or any other provision of law thereto enabling, in an amount not to exceed \$850,000 or so much as may be necessary after deducting grants or other sources of funds therefore provided, however, that the appropriation and bond authorization for North Road Sewer Project and North Road Sewer Project, Phase III does not exceed \$3,950,000 and the First Selectman and the Town Treasurer be authorized to issue and sell bonds or temporary notes of the Town not to exceed \$850,000 in anticipation of the receipt of the proceeds from the sale of such bonds and to determine the amount, date, date of maturity, interest rate, form and other details of such notes and bonds and (2) that the First Selectman be authorized to acquire for the Town by purchase or eminent domain any easements or interests in real property necessary or appropriate to construct or complete the Project. The full text of the resolutions adopted by the Board of Selectmen and the Board of Finance concerning the North Road Sewer Project, Phase II are available for review at the Town Clerk's office.






