

ANNOUNCING NEW
East Windsor Large (Bulky) Item Pickup Program
Effective February 1, 2011



In addition to our current trash services (that is, weekly trash pickup, biweekly recycling pickup, and twice a year bulky waste dropoff), East Windsor will provide large item pickup for a fee, beginning February 1, 2011. Please see the following process:

1.  East Windsor resident calls All American Waste (AAW) at 860-289-7850.
Note: These large item pickups will take place the last full week of a given month, one day allowed per month per household.
2. The AAW customer service person will ask for the items that the resident wants to discard; the charge will be \$50.00 for the first item, \$100.00 for two items and \$150.00 for three items, three items maximum per pick up. For appliances that contain Freon, there will be an additional fee of \$15.00 per unit for Freon removal.



(up to 3 items only)

3.  Once quoted, the resident will be asked for a credit card number if they want the service. AAW will charge the credit card for the agreed amount and give the resident the pick up day. A check may be sent in if resident DOES NOT WISH TO USE A CREDIT CARD. The check must be received before the pick up is scheduled. AAW will pick up one day a month (during the last full week of the month). NOTE: AAW will only pick up what was agreed upon, if there are any extra items they will be left behind.

NOTE: Bulky Waste Dropoffs occur two (2) times a year. These Scheduled Dropoffs are Free of Charge.

Consumer electronics include items such as computers, monitors, televisions, iPods, PDA's, pagers, VCRs, radios, telephones and other small electronic devices. **Items that are in good working order can be donated to charities** such as [Goodwill Industries](#), [Salvation Army](#), or can be offered on [FreeCycle](#) or [Craigslist](#). Items that are no longer useful should be recycled at a local electronics collection.

Staples stores offer recycling of computers and peripherals (that include monitors, printers, and hard drives). **Office Depot** also offers computer, printer, and monitor recycling. **Best Buy** stores will recycle old televisions up to 32".
