* Note: Must be taped together, put in a container, or wrapped in cloth during transport to prevent breakage (or cracked glass).

The following items are (**not acceptable**) NOT collectable:

Asbestos	Explosives	Propane Tanks (for grills)
Biological Waste	Latex Paint	Tires (1 allowed in trash bin per week)
**Car Batteries	Medical Waste	**Waste Oil
Fire Extinguishers	Medicines/Drugs	Wastes from any Business

Note: Curbside pickup on recycling days – place **NEXT TO recycle bin.

Safe Handling Tips

- Whenever possible, bring materials in their original containers.
- Don't mix different products together in one container. Some of them may react violently with each other.
- If possible, pack containers separately in absorbent material to prevent breakage or leakage.
- Bring rags/towels in your car to clean up any spills.
- If a leak or spill occurs en route to site, stop car, wipe up substance, and open windows to vent fumes. Bring rags/towels to collection site for disposal
