

Program Information

The East Windsor Parks and Recreation Department has the right to cancel, reschedule or relocate a program or event according to facility availability and public participation. We may also enforce a minimum and/or maximum number of participants needed to make a program viable. Our programs are self funding which means in order for them to run we need to get the enrollment that is necessary. Please don't wait until the last minute to sign up. Registration Process

The East Windsor Parks and Recreation Department accepts registration on an in-person basis during posted office hours. We also accept registration through the mail-in process, as well as online. Programs are on a first-come first-serve basis, and we must obtain sufficient registrations to make the programs successful. Non-residents can register for our programs, special fees will be posted on a class-by-class basis.



Payment / Refund Policies

Payment must be paid in full at the time of registration unless otherwise stated in the program information. We accept cash and checks payable to "East Windsor Parks and Recreation." Returned checks will be charged a \$20 fee. Register with our new Online Payment Option. Sign up for most of our programs without leaving your house. 


Men's Open Gym
