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

Parent Information for Summer Fun Camp 2009

The camp staff at Summer Fun Camp will go through preseason training and attend Camp College to learn the skills necessary to keep your children safe while at Summer Camp. Our ratios for camp typically are Ages 6-12 1:10 and for Ages 4-5 it is 1:5.

Our staff is not permitted to dispense medication or apply sun-screen. We will do frequent sun checks and water breaks throughout the day. **Make sure you make the counselors aware of any medication your child is taking or has taken in the past, which may affect energy level, moods, or physical ability (i.e. Ritalin).**

All camper information and emergency contacts are kept at Camp and must be brought with the Camper the first day of the session. Multiple copies do not have to be made if your child is attending multiple sessions. Please be sure to give us up to date information on Emergency Contacts as well as how we can reach you during the day. Cell Phones work best for after work hours. Make sure that your child wears comfortable and protective footwear such as sneakers. Please, no flip flops or sandals. (Sandals are only permitted to be worn during Free Swim.)

Top Ten Things to Bring to Camp Everyday:

1. Backpack for belongings.
2. Sunscreen: Please review with your child how to put sunscreen on or send a spray bottle of sunscreen, as counselors are not allowed to apply the lotion to the child.
3. Lunch: to be brought from home or purchased at the snack bar
4. Labeled water bottle.
5. Labeled drinking cup for snack time. Camp does NOT provide cups.
6. Snacks/or money to purchase snack from snack bar for extended day.
7. Sweatshirt in the event of cooler weather.
8. Swim suit and Towel: even if they are not allowed to swim we will do daily water activities.
9. Change of clothes and plastic bag to put wet/soiled clothes in.
10. No Toys as they are sometime lost or broken.

Upon registration, a **non-refundable** \$10.00 per child, per week deposit is required. The remainder of the payment is due two weeks prior to each session. Registration will close two weeks prior to each session.

Tiny Tot Fun Camp is run separate from Summer Fun Camp but some activities will be combined such as Lunch and Free Swim.

Half Day Campers do not go swimming, but will use the sprinkler on a daily basis.

Field Trips are not available to Tiny Tots, but special interest events and crafts will be brought to the camp.

Half-Day Camp:

9 a.m. to Noon: \$50 per week

Non-Residents add \$5 per week/per child

Full-Day Camp is the same as Summer Fun Camp.

Space is Limited to 10 campers per session.
