

Registration Policies and Procedures:



Program Information: The East Windsor Parks and Recreation Department has the right to cancel, reschedule or relocate a program or event according to facility availability and public participation. We may also enforce a minimum and/or maximum number of participants needed to make a program viable. Our programs are self-funding which means in order for them to run we need to get the enrollment that is necessary. Please don't wait until the last minute to sign up. These programs are for you and your children and cannot be held without participation. ***Sign up Today!!!*** Thank you for your support.



Registration Process: The East Windsor Parks and Recreation Department accepts registration on an in-person basis during posted office hours. We also accept registration through the mail-in process and have drop boxes located at all East Windsor Town Buildings and Schools. Programs are on a first-come/first-serve basis, and we must obtain enough registrations to make the program successful. Non-residents can register for our programs; special fees will be posted on a class-by-class basis.



Payment/Refund Policies: Payment must be paid in full at the time of registration unless otherwise stated in the program information. We accept cash and checks payable to “East Windsor Parks and Recreation.” Returned checks will be charged a \$15 fee.

After a program begins *NO REFUNDS* will be given unless extenuating circumstances prevents you from participating in the program. The cost of trips is also non-refundable.

WRESTLING: Join us for our *new program* open to all students in grades 5 - 8; *no experience necessary.* This program is coached by the East Windsor High School certified wrestling coaches, and is designed to teach the basics of the sport. The program will be offered every Monday and Friday from 5 -7 p.m. at the East Windsor High School Auxiliary Gym. The program starts November 30, 2009, and will run through the end of February, 2010. *No classes 12/25, 12/28, 1/1, 1/18, 2/15, and 2/29.* *The cost of the program is \$60.*



SHOWCASE CINEMA TICKETS: We will once again be selling discounted movie tickets to be used at Showcase Cinemas. *The cost of the tickets are \$7.75 each*, and can be used at any time. Tickets can be picked up at the Parks and Recreation Office (now located in the East Windsor High School, 76 South Main Street, EW).

OPEN SKATING AT TWIN RINKS: *Wednesday, December 30th* at Enfield Twin Rinks, 1 Prior Road, Enfield from 12:00—2:00 p.m. **This program is \$4 per skater, and open to all East Windsor residents.** Skate rental will be available on a first-come/first-serve basis and is \$3 per rental.



GYMNASTICS CLASSES: We will be hosting another session of gymnastics at Airtime Gymnastics on Wednesdays. This session will begin on January 6th and run through February 24th. **Classes will be held during school vacation. The fee for this 8 week program offered through the Parks and Recreation Department is \$100 per student.** Children in grades K-4 will have classes from 4:30—5:30 p.m. and children in grades 5-8 will have classes from 6:00—7:00 p.m. Space is limited to the first 24 students per time slot. **Registration must be received at the Parks and Recreation Office.** Please call 860-627-6662, or Keith at Airtime at 860-627-7300.



CRPA HOT SHOT CONTEST: EW Parks and Recreation Department, in association with CT Recreation and Parks Association, presents the **17th Annual Hot Shot Contest for Boys and Girls ages 9-15.** Age is determined as of December 31, 2009. The age brackets are: 9-10, 11-12, and 13-15. The contest will take place on **Thursday, January 7th, 2010** at the East Windsor High School Gym. Competitions begin at 6:45 p.m. Pre-registration is required; **there is no fee for this contest.** Birth Certificates will be needed if athlete advances to the **County Round which, we are proud to announce, will be hosted in East Windsor on February 6th and 7th.**



AFTER SCHOOL BOWLING PROGRAM: Come join us for this fun and exciting after-school 10 week bowling program for students in grades K-4 and 5-8. **Tuesday Session:** starts January 12th and ends March 9th; **no bowling February 16th.** **Wednesday Session:** starts January 13th and ends March 10th; **no bowling February 17th.** Students in grades 5-8 will take the chaperoned bus from EW Middle School at 3:15 p.m. and parent pickup will be at 4:45 p.m. Students in grades K-4 will take a chaperoned bus from the Broad Brook Elementary School at 4:00 p.m. and parents pick up will be at 5:30 p.m. **Parents must pick up students at the bowling alley. The cost of each 10 week program is \$100, and must be paid in full prior to this program starting. Checks can be made payable to Bradley Bowl!** **Registration through the Parks and Recreation Office must be received by January 7, 2010.** We need 10-15 registrations per age group or the program will be cancelled.

Classes will be held at the Broad Brook School on Wednesdays. **Session 1:** starts February 10th and runs through March 31st; **no class February 17th.** **Session 2:** starts April 14th and runs through June 2nd; **no class April 21.** **Fee for each 7 week program is \$89.** Classes will meet at 3:45 p.m. to 4:45 p.m. for 7 weeks. This program is for kids in grades K—4. **Checks should be made payable to Mad Science.** **Registration through the Parks and Recreation Office must be received by February 4th.** Space is limited to the first 20 students. Parent Volunteer is needed for this class.

Registrations must be made through the Parks and Recreation Office. Rental skates are available for \$3 per session but you're welcome to bring your own skates and gloves.


