

# Attention East Windsor Residents

## East Windsor is going AUTOMATED

Beginning September 8, 2009 the Automated Trash and Recycling cart distribution will begin. You may use your cart as soon as they are delivered. The blue recycling cart will be delivered first and will be picked up for the first time the week of September 21st. The gray trash cart will be delivered beginning the week of September 14th. You will be able to put the trash cart out the week of September 21st for pick up. It is important you keep 3 feet of space between the carts and away from any poles, mailboxes, etc. The room is needed so the truck is able to pick the carts up without any delay or damage to obstacles.

Trash will continue to be picked up weekly. The recycling carts will be picked up every other week. The weeks that are highlighted yellow on the inside of this flyer will be the recycling weeks, please be sure the container is out those weeks for pick up.

With the new schedule it is important that the carts are out by 6:00 am as the time of your pick up may change because of our new routing.



### Important Things To Remember

#### Christmas Tree Pickup

Will occur week of January 11, 2010.

#### Storage Batteries & Waste Oil

Please place to the side of the blue container at least 2 feet away in plain sight for pick up.  
DO NOT place inside the blue container.

#### Oversized Items & Metal Drop Off

There will be an Oversized Item drop off scheduled for October 10, 2009 and April 17, 2010 at the F&G Volume Reduction Station, 9 Shoham Road, East Windsor from 7:30 to 11:30 AM.

**ACCEPTED ITEMS:** Furniture, Mattresses, Metal, Tires (no more than 4 per household), Appliances, Normal Household Items too large for the 96 gallon cart.

**NOT ACCEPTED ITEMS:** Brush and All Other Yard Waste, Construction Debris including but not limited to Doors, Windows, Sheetrock, Any Quantity of 2x4s, Plywood, Shingles, Paint, Hazardous Waste and Propane Tanks.

### What is single-stream recycling?

It's the state of the art!

Single-stream recycling is a system in which all recyclable materials -- fiber (newspaper, cardboard, mixed paper, catalogs, magazines and junk mail) and containers (glass, steel, aluminum and plastic) -- are placed, unsorted, in one recycling bin and sorted by state-of-the-art processing equipment at a regional recycling center.

It's the easiest way to recycle!

Residents and collectors are no longer required to separate paper and containers, making curbside recycling much more convenient. And because paper and cardboard no longer need to be separated, residents don't need brown-paper bags in which to pack them.

### What are the advantages of single-stream recycling?

For residents:

- Convenience increases dramatically for residents, especially with automated collection that uses much larger wheeled recycling barrels, since it does not require separation of paper and cardboard from containers.
- The wheeled barrels reduce litter and contamination because they have lids that seal tightly.

For the environment:

- Single-stream recycling conserves more natural resources and decreases raw materials used.
- More recycling means less trash delivered to trash-to-energy facilities or trucked to out-of-state landfills.
- Easier recycling means greater residential participation that drives up recycling rates and reduces trash disposal, lowering costs to municipalities and homeowners.
- Automated collection means more efficient routes, decreasing truck emissions and fuel consumption.
