Registration Policies and Procedures

Program Information

The East Windsor Parks and Recreation Department has the right to cancel, reschedule or relocate a program or event according to facility availability and public participation. We may also enforce a minimum and/or maximum number of participants needed to make a program viable. Our programs are self funding which means in order for them to run we need to get the enrollment that is necessary. Please don't wait until the last minute to sign up. These programs are for you and your children and cannot be held without participation. So sign up Today!! Thank you for your support.

Registration Process

The East Windsor Parks and Recreation Department accepts registration on an in-person basis during posted office hours. We also accept registration through the mail-in process and our drop boxes located at Town Hall, Town Hall Annex and all three EW Schools. Programs are on a first-come first-serve basis, and we must obtain enough registrations to make the program successful. Non-residents can register for our programs, special fees will be posted on a class-by-class basis.



Payment / Refund Policies

Payment must be paid in full at the time of registration unless otherwise stated in the program information. We accept cash and checks payable to "East Windsor Parks and Recreation." Returned checks will be charged a \$15 fee.

NO REFUNDS will be given unless extenuating circumstances prevents you from participating in the program. The cost of trips are also non-refundable.

All are welcome to come and join in the fun!!! Participants should bring their own Easter Egg hunting basket. Tickets will be sold at the P&R office during office hours.

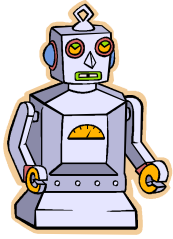

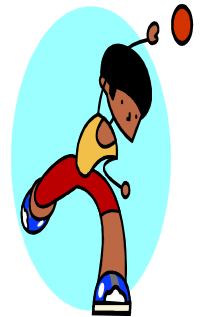

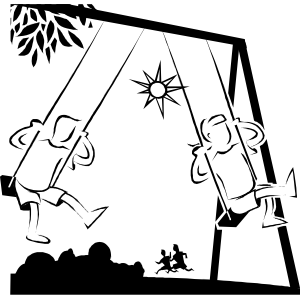
