

INVITATION TO BID

Select Municipal Buildings
Doors and Openers

East Windsor, CT

Sealed bids are invited and will be received by the Town of East Windsor, hereinafter referred to as the Owner. Bids will be received until 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 25, 2009, at the First Selectman's Office, East Windsor Town Hall, 11 Rye Street, Broad Brook, CT 06016 at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Proposals must be submitted on the forms provided and in a sealed envelope plainly marked with the appropriate title "**Select Municipal Buildings - Doors and Openers**".

The proposed scope of work includes the removal of existing doors and the installation of handicap accessible doors and automatic openers in select municipal buildings to meet ADA compliance.

Attention of bidders is directed to certain requirements of this contract which require payment of Davis-Bacon wages, and compliance with certain local, state and federal requirements. This is a Federally funded project.

A satisfactory Bid Security, in the form of a Bid Bond, shall be submitted with the bid. The Bid Security shall be made payable to the Town of East Windsor and shall be properly executed by the Bidder and Acceptable Sureties.

The Project Manual and Bid Documents which include Information for Bidders, Form of Bid, Specifications, and other contract documents will be available at the First Selectman's Office, East Windsor Town Hall, 11 Rye Street, Broad Brook, CT 06016. Office hours are Mon. - Wed. 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m., Thurs. 8:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m., Fri. 8:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.

A pre-bid inspection will be held at Select Municipal Buildings, starting at East Windsor Town Hall, 11 Rye Street, East Windsor, CT at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 12, 2009. All prospective bidders are urged to attend.

The Owner reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids; to waive any informalities, or; to accept any bid deemed in the best interests of the Town of East Windsor or the Town of East Windsor.

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of forty-five (45) days.
