- V. NEW BUSINESS
  - Clark Chapin, Town Planner, has been reviewing the Town Plan of Conservation and Development. A POCD implementation committee is being formed. Albert Grant would like to be involved in a limited capacity. Albert Grant reminded that the commission has scored farmland properties over 30 acres (to qualify for Dept. of Ag. purchase of development rights) and under 30-acre parcels (to qualify for Community Farms grant program).
  - 2. Clark Chapin inquired of Catholic Church regarding the status of their farmland property in Windsorville. They want to preserve it for cemetery use.

Reiterated we should take a soil sample for testing. Where does Nutrien AG solutions, send their samples? Maybe ask Bill Syme. Albert Grant will get soil samples done.

Regarding water to the Garden:

Clark Chapin reported that the town has found some money to bring water from the Reservoir, across the street. How will that work? Hydrant or line to the tank. Public works will do the work. Commission hopes to have input.

- 2. Horse Drawn Plowing event at Community Garden April 17, and rain date 24<sup>th.</sup> Peg Hoffman is working on a poster for publicity. There will be 3 teams of horses.
- 3. Albert Grant had applied for a CIP (Capital Improvement Planning) grant for Kogut Farm restoration. The CIP money has not been allocated yet; in budgetary process. Is the state still funding that grant?
- 4. The list of Agricultural businesses in town has been submitted to the Selectman's office for inclusion in the May Town newsletter.
