- The Section 5510 program provides federal funding for capital and operating expenses to improve mobility for seniors and individuals with disabilities by removing barriers to transportation service and expanding transportation mobility options.

 - o Operators of public transportation
 - Taxi companies may participate in the Section 5910 program as contractors, and must apply via a coordinating entity, such as a conprofit organization or transit district.
