the architectural/engineering study, next is to get the engineering blueprints and then they will be able to apply for the grant. She believes we are looking at approximately 3 more years. It was suggested to contact Ellington's Senior Center as well as Bolton's Senior Center to see what they did as far as building brand new facilities for their Senior Centers. There was a brief discussion regarding the POCD and the revitalization of Warehouse Point.
