Open Space and Farmland Brochure

Open Space and Farmland Preservation

2. Albert Grant reported that there will be a Town meeting on Sept. 1, 2022 to appropriate \$150,000 for the Town Open Space Fund.

Combined with the present balance, that should restore the fund to nearly where it was previous to the last expenditure made to help preserve Riverbend Farm via the State purchase of development rights.

- 3. We looked at the Agricultural Commission page on the Town website to see what is on the list of resources for land preservation.
- 4. Our article was written to address the general public as well as landowners who might want to preserve their land. As we have discussed before, we want to create a letter meant specifically for contact with landowners. We have a draft letter that we can edit.

The CT Farmland Trust decided the Federal program was not a good fit. Kathleen Doherty would like a tour of East Windsor's Farmland and an informal meeting.
