#### 1. Budget 2022/23

- <u>Ruthanne Calabrese</u>: The Department is set with its budget. And, we have not made any requests for this year.
- <u>James Richards</u>: I want to make sure that we have enough money for the Recording Secretary, and Professional Services. We also need to make sure that we have \$5,000 in house for the needed services.

<u>Gilbert Hayes</u>: What does Mike do?

- <u>Ruthanne Calabrese:</u> Mike D'Amato is a professional consultant who does a lot of work for us like marketing, writing a Zoning regulation. He is a strategist. He is an interim town planner. He is an independent contractor. We are working on networking and PR.
- <u>James Richards</u>: There are national and agricultural grants available for the town. We could apply for a grant writer or an economic consultant.

# 3. Route 5 Corridor Study

<u>Gilbert Hayes</u>: I have looked into Route 5 bus routes. I have retired from the bus transportation company that serves individuals with disabilities. The CNA needs the bus route transportation from Broad Brooke, as there is none available. <u>James Richards</u>: We might be able to look into the Agricultural Grant. The Great Hartford Transit needs an ADA Compliant transit.

# 4. Commercial Real Estate and How We Can Promote?

- James Richards: Since our last meeting, I went to the WPCA meeting where people were getting wrong information. We do have a security situation regarding the information sharing. If the town could provide us with a list of properties, could we provide the town staff with the sewer lines? Sewer lines = Zoning and building regulations. So, we could attract potential real estate buyers. Who are the stakeholders in building commercial and residential properties? The idea is to create a real estate portfolio including concept plans. We could also look into the federal infrastructure programs that got passed in Congress. We could streamline the information. I do not want to promote a commercial property that may not have a real potential. I did discuss this matter with WPCA to make it attractive for the businesses.
- <u>Ruthanne Calabrese</u>: We have a list of properties on our Town's website from which some could be promoted using the conceptual framework. We are just starting to work on the real estate commercial properties.
- James Richards: We want to move forward with caution. And, not let the momentum go.

James Richard has provided a list of business that are really grateful to receive the grant.
