ABSENTEE BALLOTS

- Absentee Ballots, for those who qualify, will be available from 10/4/2019 to 11/4/2019 in the Town Clerk's Office for the Municipal Election being held on Tuesday, 11/5/2019.
- You can pick up an absentee ballot application at the Town Clerks Office or call and have one sent to you.
- The Town Clerk's Office hours are:
Mon. - Wed. 8:30a.m. – 4:30p.m.
Thurs. 8:30a.m. – 7:00p.m.
Fri. 8:30a.m. – 1:00p.m.
- No absentee ballots can be issued on the day of the Municipal Election.

POLLING PLACES & HOURS OPEN

- District No. 1 – Town Hall Annex, 25 School St., East Windsor
- District No. 2 – Town Hall, 11 Rye St., Broad Brook
- The polls will be open during the hours between 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M.
- Election Day Registration (EDR Ballots) will only be available at District #1- Town Hall Annex, 25 School St., East Windsor.

The following is a list of reasons for requesting absentee ballots:

1. Your active service in the Armed Forces of the United States
2. Your absence from the town during all of the hours of voting
3. Your illness
4. Your religious tenets forbid secular activity on the day of the election
5. Your duties as an election official at a polling place other than your own during all of the hours of voting
6. Your physical disability
