Deputy Chief Hart explained the virus had gone through much of the department, starting with Dispatch and then to the Officers, but they were all only out for a short period of time. Lt. Carl added that no one is out now due to the virus. Commissioner Filipone asked if it was the Omicron variant. Deputy Chief Hart said they assume it was the Omicron due to the timing, but they didn't have testing to determine the variant.

Chairman Leach stated he has rejoined the Hartford Gun Club and spoke to the Manager and President about the East Windsor Police Department joining for the cost of \$1,500 per year. We could use the facility for training on Mondays and Tuesdays when no one else is there. We would have the opportunity to use all of the facility including the indoor range. If we need to do low light training, we will just need to give a week's notice. He thinks this is a win/win situation. He recommends at next month's meeting to use \$1,500 from the private duty fund to become a corporate member of the gun club. Commissioner Filipone asked if the location is in East Granby. Chairman Leach stated it is. Deputy Chief Hart stated we should bring our firearms instructor to the location prior to next month's meeting to ensure it meets the standards for our training needs. Chairman Leach will get the gun club's contact information to Deputy Chief Hart and Lt. Carl so they can set something up.
