Chief DeMarco covered the FY 18/19 police department budget line by line. It is a .99% request (less than 1%). The Capital Purchases line went up because the department is asking for two new tasers. The equipment we currently have is antiquated and not working properly; the shift needs to be covered with them at all times. Furthermore, the new cartridges/guns do not integrate with the old equipment. A discussion ensued. Chief DeMarco ended with - it's a very reasonable budget that does not impact the services that we provide to the community today.

MOTION made by Commissioner Hayes to approve the proposed budget for the East Windsor police department FY 2018/2019 to go to the Board of Finance.
