Chairman Strempfer congratulated Deputy Chief Hart on completing his Master's of Science Degree in Public Administration and noted that Officer Leab and Lieutenant Poliquin will also be receiving their Master's of Science Degree in Public Administration shortly.

10. PUBLIC INPUT – Comments and Discussion (5 minutes maximum time per subject)

First Selectman Robert Maynard inquired about the town needing new radios. Deputy Chief Hart explained a new radio system is very costly (over a million dollars) and that a better radio system would be beneficial to the town for public safety (police, fire, EMS). Deputy Chief Hart went on to explain how the radios work off a trunking system; the current radio system has a delay of a few seconds that a public safety system normally would not have. If there was a large catastrophe, the current system may not be able to handle all departments trying to simultaneously use the system. A newer system would allow for live and immediate use by all of public safety simultaneously. The current system could be kept and used by public works and the school system. Chief DeMarco suggested creating a committee that the police department could be a part of and researching this matter further. First Selectman Robert Maynard agreed this is an important matter and should be looked into. Deputy Chief stated he would start some research on the cost of the radios.
