## 1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER AND ATTENDANCE:

Commissioner Long asked what the Looseleaf Law bill was for. Chief DeMarco explained it's for the law books and field manuals for the officers. Commissioner Burns asked if we have a list of the vendors and what we use them for. Chairman Leach stated there is no list available, but any vendor they don't recognize they can ask anytime.

Deputy Chief Hart went on to say each Treasurer has their own way of doing things and we don't know what she wants; she may want to transfer money or leave it as is. They just need to meet with her to see how she wants to proceed. Once they have an answer they will report back to the police commission at next meeting. A discussion ensued.
