Chief DeMarco explained she is the instructor for our emergency medical training required for the officers. Commissioner Leach asked what the Chinook Medical Gear cost was for. Deputy Chief Hart explained it was for emergency treatment training such as applying tourniquets, etc. and emergency equipment. Chief DeMarco added it also included firearms training.
