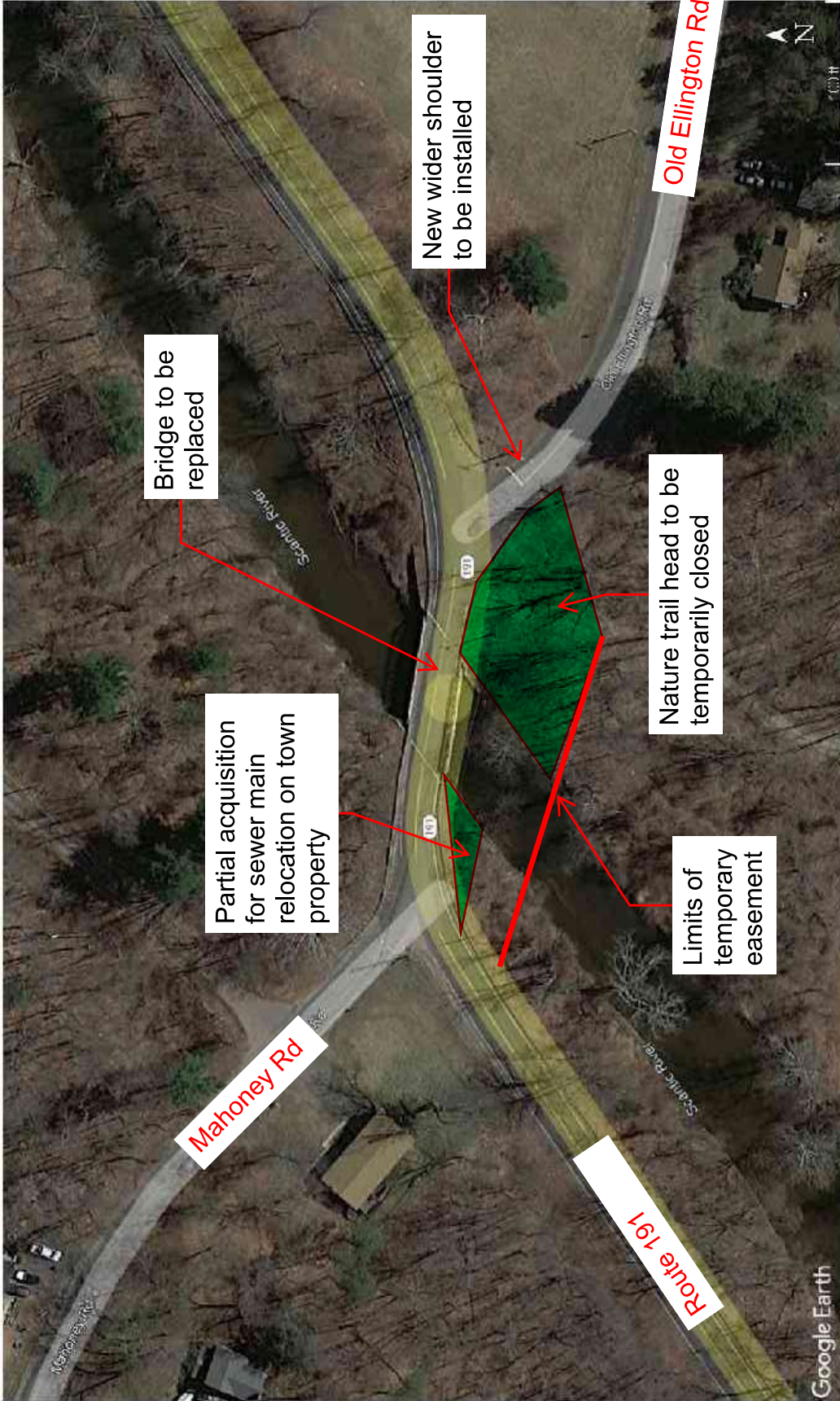


Subject: Replacement of Bridge 01524 carrying Route 191 over the Scantic River

EAST WINDSOR – State Project 0046-0127 will replace the existing truss bridge carrying Route 191 and relocate the overhead utilities and sewer main. The department is soliciting public comments regarding the use of the abutting public recreation land for construction activities including a temporary access road and a permanent relocated underground sewer main.

Easements and partial acquisitions are required from the Town for the abutting town property that is designated for public recreation. A partial acquisition is required for the relocation of the existing sewer main. It will encompass only the area necessary for the proposed construction activities, and all disturbed areas will be restored upon project completion. The impacts during construction will be limited to a temporary closure of the existing nature trailhead, and restricted access to the riverbanks adjacent to the limits of the temporary easement. These will be closed in the interest of public safety during construction. Under this project we will be reconstructing portions of Route 191, Mahoney Rd and Old Ellington Rd. Included in this reconstruction will be a wide shoulder at Old Ellington Rd to improve access to the trailhead and river. The Scantic River State Park Access and the Sabonis Landing to the north and south, respectively, of the project location will be unaffected by construction activities.
