Summer Camp Director & Assistant Camp Director

Candidates should have previous experience as a camp counselor or in a similar position. Applicants should be decisive, flexible, responsible and possess strong leadership skills. The Camp Director and Assistant Camp Director will work closely together and be responsible for supervision, guidance and direction of all camp counselors as well as organizing the day to day schedule of summer camp. They should be comfortable communicating with parents and handling issues as they may arise.

Summer Camp Counselors

To succeed as a Camp Counselor, applicants should be upbeat, decisive, and responsible. You should also be organized and possess strong leadership skills. Staff must have previous experience working or volunteering with children, be self-motivated and able to make quick decisions with minimal oversight. Camp Counselors will be responsible for organizing daily games and activities for campers, as well as supervising campers on field trips and at the waterfront daily for camp swim.

Lifeguards

Lifeguards are responsible for scanning their assigned zone, recognizing potential emergency situations, and responding accordingly by enforcing facility rules and regulations, utilizing training from the American Red Cross. Applicants must hold a current lifeguard certification or be enrolled in a lifeguard class. Lifeguards are considered the first responders to all emergencies at East Windsor Park.

Swim Instructors

Swim Instructors are responsible for providing high quality swim lessons during the summer months. Instructors must be able to provide feedback to both students and parents, while also maintaining the safety of all students during lessons. Applicants should hold a current water safety instructor certification or have prior experience teaching swim lessons. Experience in lifeguarding and mechanics of swimming is also preferred.

Gatehouse & Snack Bar Attendants

Gatehouse & Snack Bar staff are responsible for taking in admission at the gate and operating the snack bar. This includes such responsibilities as money handling, operating grills and fryers, keeping inventory of supplies and cleaning. Potential applicants should be self-motivated, organized and personable. Prior experience with handling money and/or food service is a plus.
