I have full knowledge that basketball carries significant risk of personal injury, severe injury, even death. I also agree that, as the parent/guardian to the noted child, that I am responsible for my child's safety, and in case of injury, I understand that I am responsible for all financial liabilities. To the best of my knowledge, my child is in good physical condition, has no condition that would be aggravated by participating, and has no communicable disease that could affect other participants. I acknowledge that said player is presently covered by insurance. I agree to allow immediate medical care if needed. I agree to hold harmless East Windsor Youth Basketball, and those associated with the organizations including, but not limited to, the organizers, officers, managers, coaches, referees, facility providers, and league participants for any injury incurred as a result of participating in this league or traveling for games or practices. I agree to allow pictures taken in a basketball setting and can be published in newspapers and/or league websites.

- Travel player fee is \$100 plus uniform cost of approx. \$35 (you keep the uniform)
- The season consists of practices, preseason jamboree, 16 game schedule, scrimmages, and playoffs.
- Player's playing time per game will vary based upon score, player's ability, attitude and dedication.
- Players are expected to attend all practices and all games, as practices are equally important as games.
- Players should receive *on the average* a minimum of ¼ game time, provided the player demonstrates the proper attitude, level of dedication and possess the needed skills.
- All parents are required to volunteer 3 hours to help with the Preseason Jamboree. Those that do not will be assessed an additional \$25 to their child's travel playing fee. Weekends of Nov 14 & 21.
- If a coach, parent or player is expelled by an official from a game, they cannot participate or attend the next game.
- If a parent/family member consistently displays conduct detrimental to the team, they may be banned from the gym for the next scheduled practice/game. Continued inappropriate actions may result in exclusion for the remainder of the season. We are here to promote a positive experience for the players and all involved.
- We play as a team. Players should be positive about themselves and their teammates at all times
- Winning is the result of possessing adequate skills, preparing adequately, executing properly, improving continuously, and playing to your fullest abilities at practices as well as games
- We represent ourselves, our team, our parents, our coaches, and our town, and should act appropriately
- We understand that sicknesses can occur, vacations planned. However, if a player fails to fully commit, and fails to attend practices and games on a consistent basis (i.e. sleepovers, too tired, , going to movies, etc.) or if the player's conduct is detrimental to the team, playing time could decrease, or the player could be dismissed from the team forfeiting all fees.
- Uniforms are a separate cost with the player keeping the uniform. Uniforms must be paid in full at time of order.
- **With COVID, current rules include: mask must be worn by everyone once you enter the school. Spectators are limited to 1 per player and must sit 6 feet apart. If you have Covid or in the testing process, you are not allowed in the building. Noted COVID rules may change based upon school guidelines. Bench Players & Coaches must sit 3 ft apart with masks.**
- Failure to abide by the rules may result in a decrease in playing time or dismissal with fees non-refundable

- **Zero Tolerance Policy: A Zero Tolerance Policy is in place, whereas, if a player, coach, and/or spectator harasses, threatens and/or harms a player, coach, spectator, or official and/or instigates such actions; that person shall be requested to leave the facility/grounds immediately and may not be permitted to return for the next planned game, practice or activity.
