

## EAST WINDSOR COMMUNITY GARDEN

2023 Garden Rules

- 1. Gardens to be used for private individuals, no retail or commercial ventures are allowed.
- 2. Fencing, tools, hoses, and fertilizer, as <u>needed</u>; must be supplied by the gardener.
- 3. No herbicides, such as Preen or Round-Up and others, or systemic insecticides may be used.
- 4. Each gardener is responsible for the up-keep of his or her plot. Weeds and debris may not be left in the walkways. Abandoned plots will be reassigned. Failure to commence cultivating the plot no later than the opening date of the garden (May 1) will result in the relinquishment of the plot.
- 5. Any rocks brought into the garden must be taken out at the end of the season. No rocks can be tossed into the walkways. There will be 2 designated areas for rocks, one on either side of the garden. They will be marked with a stake.
- 6. No plastic used for tying up plants or other purposes, only biodegradable material. They get left behind and get tangled in the rototiller and are not environmentally friendly. It lasts for thousands of years.
- 7. Be considerate of the premises of your neighbors.
- 8. All fencing and material other than plants must be removed by September 30<sup>th</sup> or a killing frost. Those who don't clean up their plots will not be allowed to garden in subsequent years.
- 9. Park only in the area designated for the Community Gardens. <u>DO NOT</u> park in the Dog Park parking lot.
