
Today we were notified of two additional confirmed positive cases of COVID-19. According to our local health district, that brings the total number of confirmed cases in East Windsor to forty-one, an increase of fourteen cases since Thursday. As of yesterday, there were 25,269 confirmed cases statewide.

We've had some complaints about local businesses not adhering to some of the safety guidelines issued in Governor Lamont's executive orders. Our police department is aware of these complaints and are taking appropriate steps to prevent public harm. However, if you must be out and you see safety measures at public places being disregarded, please remove yourself from harm. Go home or go to another store that may be less risk to you. And if you do need to leave your house for any reason, remember to avoid touching your face, practice social distancing, and wash your hands regularly.

We've been doing well with measures that will help flatten the curve and get us through this pandemic as quickly and as safely as possible. As Henry Ford said: "coming together is a beginning, staying together is progress, and working together is success."
