This is First Selectman Jason E. Bowsza reaching out to all town residents. A copy of this message will be listed on the Town's website when possible. As of this call, there are still 580 homes still without power.

Most remaining outages are on three major circuits. When the issues with those circuits are fixed, we'll see more than 90% of the outstanding power outages restored. We expect that work to be completed overnight. Eversource has issued an estimated time of restoration for the Town for 6am on Monday morning, although we are trending well ahead of that.

With more than 580 homes still without power, the Town has made the decision that we will continue offering cooling/charging stations and showers through tomorrow. A cooling/charging station will be open at the Town Hall Annex from 11am to 4pm, and showers are available until 1pm today at East Windsor High School.

When you see restoration crews on the road, please remember they have been working long hours over several days. Please give them the space to work and concentrate without distracting them.

Over the next several days, individual outages may persist. Please report those to Eversource at 1-800-286-2000, even if they have been reported before. Our Eversource community liaison continues to have calls with us multiple times per day, and he has stressed the benefit of reporting those individual outages through the Eversource report line.
