
Good evening,

This is First Selectman Jason Bowsza reaching out to all residents of the Town of East Windsor

Today, the town partnered with USDA, the Connecticut Department of Agriculture, and the East Windsor Hunger Action Team to provide a Farmers to Families Food Box Distribution event. We were able to distribute boxes of food to more than 1,100 families in the region. I want to give a special thank you to Southern Auto Auction, who provided the space and some manpower and I want to thank the fifteen volunteers who helped make today's event a success. We still have 170 boxes of food that will be distributed tomorrow at 5 Phelps Road, beginning at 9am while supplies last. This is a first come, first serve event. Please do not get out of your cars and please make sure that you have room in your trunk.

Tomorrow, we will be holding another COVID vaccine clinic at the Town Hall Annex. We have a very limited number of spots still available, and we are continuing to add additional names to our COVID vaccine waiting list by age group. Anyone interested in adding their name to the list, and for receiving vaccine in East Windsor, please call the Department of Community Services at 860-623-2430. You do NOT need to be eligible to receive the vaccine to be added to the wait list, but you won't be able to get the vaccine until your age group is eligible.
