
We have had twenty-three cases of COVID-19 confirmed in East Windsor last week, and twenty-four this week. These show a continued very positive trend compared to previous weeks.

The Town continues to partner with Priority Urgent Care to offer live virus testing and antibody testing every Wednesday from 10am to 3pm at the Town Hall Annex, 25 School Street, East Windsor. This is open to anyone, and all insurances are accepted. Depending on individual insurance plans, patients may be responsible for either a copay or deductible. People without insurance will be tested at no charge. Anyone interested is strongly encouraged to schedule appointments ahead of time by calling 860-454-0678.

The Town of East Windsor is cosponsoring a COVID-19 vaccine distribution clinic with the North Central District Health Department next Thursday, February 4 from 10a-4p at the Town Hall Annex. This is available to anyone 75 years old and older, or anyone who is Phase 1A-eligible, and all participants MUST be enrolled through Vaccine Administration Management System (VAMS). Appointments are absolutely required, and VAMS scheduling information is available on the Town website. Vaccine supplies are very limited, so people are encouraged to make their VAMS profile as soon as possible. For assistance in setting up the profile, participants can contact the Senior Center, the Social Services Office, or the Parks and Recreation Office.

Many people may still have questions about the risks and benefits of taking the vaccine when they are eligible. The Town has posted a [video](#) on our website featuring Dr. David Agus, Professor of Medicine at University of Southern California, in which the doctor addresses many questions about the vaccine.
