Good evening,

This is First Selectman Jason Bowsza reaching out to all residents of the Town of East Windsor.

Tonight's planned concert at East Windsor Park is cancelled due to the weather forecast. The date will be made up later in the summer.

Speaking of the weather, our part of Connecticut has endured some extreme rain and wind over the last week. I share updates with known road closures on my facebook page and on the Town facebook page. In anticipation of Tropical Storm Elsa, we will continue to communicate closure information via those pages. If East Windsor is more significantly impacted than is anticipated, additional road closure and power outage information will be shared via this phone call system.

Please plan ahead for tomorrow's storm impact and be prepared to stay at home until it passes. Current forecasts suggest that the highest storm impact will be to the south and east of us, but that could shift. To report any road impairments, please call 911. The dispatchers route closure information to Eversource, which accelerates the repair work.

On Monday, Senator Blumenthal and Congressman Larson will be in town to join us as we announce a COVID-19 small business and nonprofit grant being offered by the Town of East Windsor. The event will be at 11am at East Windsor Park, for anyone who would like to see the announcements. Small businesses and nonprofits based in East Windsor will be able to find grant criteria and application information on the Town's website on Monday, and we will be accepting applications through August 9th. This initiative is paid for with part of the Town's allocation from the American Rescue Plan Act, and is designed to support our local business and nonprofit community.
