This is First Selectman Jason Bowsza reaching out to all residents of the Town of East Windsor.

For the first time in well over a year, our local health district reported that we had no new cases of COVID-19 in our community last week. That is exceptionally good news.

The East Windsor Police Department this week launched a new analytics dashboard that provides real-time data relating to calls for service, the active police blotter, crime trends, victimology, use of force, traffic analysis, and policies. The data is chronicled by year back to 2019 and in some cases, back to 2016. It is available on a yearly, monthly, daily, or hourly basis. It shows the frequency, type and location of different types of service calls. This interactive tool provides what we believe to be an unparalleled degree of transparency into police activity in our community. You can see for yourself where the department's efforts are being spent by going to eastwindsorpd.net.

Tomorrow, East Windsor Park fully opens for the summer. To kick the season off, we will continue our summer concert series there from 6:30p to 8p. This week's featured band will be Big Deal!
