Good evening,

This is First Selectman Jason Bowsza reaching out to all residents of the Town of East Windsor.

There have been 3 new confirmed positive cases of COVID in East Windsor since last week. According to the Department of Public Health as of March 1, seventy-five percent of East Windsor residents over the age of 75 have received at least one dose of vaccine, and fifty-five percent of residents over the age of 65 have as well.

The Town continues to offer COVID testing on Wednesdays from 10am to 3pm at the Town Hall Annex and is offered in partnership with Priority Urgent Care.

This week, we will be holding another COVID vaccine clinic. We have been notified that we will get fifty doses, and we have a waiting list of nearly four hundred people. We will continue to keep names on the list in the Department of Community Services, and we want to let people know that there are other alternatives available. Appointments for those people who are age-eligible can be found by going through CVS.com, Walgreens.com, Walmart.com/COVID or by calling the Vernon Regional Call Center at 860-896-4568. You can call 860-623-2430 to be added to the Town's waiting list, but please remember that our supply of vaccine is very limited.

On March 25th, the Town will hold another Farmers to Families Fresh Food Box distribution event at 5 Phelps Road. Specific details are being finalized and will be announced next week. We are grateful for our partners who help make this possible, including Southern Auto Auction, USDA, the Connecticut Department of Agriculture, the East Windsor Hunger Action Team, our dedicated Town staff, and our wonderful volunteers.
