Good evening,

This is First Selectman Jason Bowsza reaching out to all residents of the Town of East Windsor.

There have been 10 new confirmed positive cases of COVID in East Windsor since last week. According to the Department of Public Health as of March 24, eighty-two percent of East Windsor residents over the age of 75 have received at least one dose of vaccine, and eighty-four percent of residents over the age of 65 have as well. Overall, East Windsor is at a rate of twenty-seven percent of our population vaccinated.


We continue to hold COVID vaccine clinics whenever possible, and we will be doing another clinic this Friday. We do still have a limited number of slots available, so please call Community Services as soon as you can. For appointments or to be added to the waiting list, please call 860-623-2430. We will be offering Moderna, and anyone 18 years of age or older is eligible to sign up. We are also maintaining a waiting list for anyone who would Pfizer or Johnson & Johnson.

We also want to let people know that there are other alternatives available. Appointments can be made by visiting CVS.com, Walgreens.com, Walmart.com/COVID or by calling the Vernon Regional Call Center at 860-896-4568.

The Town continues to offer COVID testing on Wednesdays from 10am to 3pm at the Town Hall Annex and is offered in partnership with Priority Urgent Care.
