This is First Selectman Jason Bowsza reaching out to all residents of the Town of East Windsor.

This week, the Department of Public Health is reporting that the town is designated as “orange” in terms of new COVID cases, with an average per 100,000 people of 13.5. This comes after some very encouraging numbers last week, which saw us move into a “yellow” designation, followed by some concerning numbers over the weekend that pushed us back up to “orange”.

This past weekend, the Warehouse Point Fire District dedicated their new fire house expansion in memory of beloved long-time firefighter Anthony “Tony D” DiMastrantonio. Congratulations to Chief Barton and the entire fire district on that significant accomplishment and worthy dedication.
