Chairman Madigan noted the Commission has established a quorum with five of the following members present. Chairman Madigan, Vice Chairman Macsata, Commissioner Hayes, Commissioner Loos, Commissioner Masters.

Chairman Madigan announced this opportunity for the public to offer comments or raise questions. No one requested to speak.

4. **BUDGET DISCUSSION:**

Chairman Madigan noted the Budget had been presented to the Commissioners at the previous Regular Meeting, he asked if anyone wanted to discuss line items, or the Budget as proposed?

Vice Chairman Macsata wanted to thank the Chiefs and anyone else who assisted putting the proposed Budget together; it's been well done.

Commissioner Loos cited the minimal cost per taxpayer related to the proposed Budget, but he questioned if the CIP (Capital Improvement Projects) line item should be increased?

Commissioner Hayes wished everyone a Happy New Year. He suggested the Commissioners could make the request, but the CIP funding amount is set by the CIP Committee; it would be at their discretion to propose an increase.

Assistant Chief Bancroft clarified that the BBFD is no longer part of the Town Budget, and no longer receives a CIP allocation.

Vice Chairman Macsata asked Chief Arcari if he felt the Budget as proposed should be increased, or if he feels it's appropriate as proposed? Chief Arcari indicated he felt it was ok for this year as proposed.

Chairman Madigan asked if any other Commissioners had any comments; no one requested to speak.

Chairman Madigan noted the BBFD will vote on the proposed Budget submission at its Regular Meeting scheduled for January 24th, 2022.

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Hearing no requests for discussion he called for a motion to Adjourn.
