Chairman Madigan called the December 13, 2021 Regular Meeting of the Broad Brook Fire Commission to Order at 7:00 p.m. The Meeting is being held in the Senior Center Meeting Room above the Broad Brook Fire station located at 125 Main Street, Broad Brook, CT, and is being held via teleconference as well to encourage greater public participation.

#### 2. ROLL CALL:

Chairman Madigan noted the Commission has established a quorum with six members present. Chairman Madigan, Commissioner Loos, Commissioner Masters, Commissioner Myers were present at the Fire Station; Commissioner Hayes and Commissioner Ouellette joined the Commission virtually.

Vice Chairman Macsata was unable to attend this meeting; Fire Marshal Rich Austin was unable to attend the Broad Brook Fire Department Commission Meeting due to a conflict with a meeting of the Warehouse Point Fire District.

#### 5. <u>COMMUNICATIONS:</u>

Chairman Madigan has not received any communications for this meeting.

#### 6. REPORT OF THE FIRE CHIEF:

No report this evening.

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#### 7. REPORT FROM FIRE MARSHAL AUSTIN/To include discussion of penalty fees:

Chairman Madigan reported Fire Marshal Austin will not be able to participate in the Commission's meeting this evening due to a conflict with a meeting of the Warehouse Point Fire District.

Chairman Madigan advised the group that he has sent an e-mail to Lou Flynn, Chairman of the Warehouse Point Fire District, regarding sharing the cost of Fire Marshal Austin's expenses. Communication remains pending.

#### 8. STATUS OF BROAD BROOK FIRE DEPARTMENT BUDGET:

Chief Arcari referenced two documents related to the Broad Brook Fire Department Budget; he noted the single page is the Department's budget through 12/1/2021. He suggested the only concern is perhaps an increase in the cost of fuel.

The second document is a draft of the Department's Budget submission to the Board of Selectmen. A second Budget Workshop Meeting has been scheduled for the Commissioners for January 10, 2022. The Commission anticipates holding that meeting prior to Budget submission on February 1, 2022.

#### 9. <u>UPDATE ON STATUS OF VEHICLE REPLACEMENT:</u>

Chief Arcari reported the Legal Notice for the submission of bids for the replacement vehicle appeared in the Journal Inquirer on Saturday, December 4, 2021. Chief Arcari explained the specifics of the bid process as advertised. Chairman Madigan questioned when the vehicle would be ordered? Chief Arcari indicated the contract with the winning bidder must be signed by First Selectman Bowsza to finalize the order; delivery of the vehicle could be expected to occur approximately 480 days after signature of the contract by the First Selectman. Commissioner Loos questioned if the Department is considering a 5-year payback and a 7-year payback? Chief Arcari suggested that information will be discussed during the bid acceptance process.

#### 10. QUESTIONS/COMMENTS FROM COMMISSION MEMBERS:

Chief Arcari reported that with regard to the Department's Budget the bottom line for the 2022 Fiscal Year is that everything is the same as last year. Chairman Madigan suggested the townspeople will be pleased to see a zero budget increase. The Commission reiterated their intent to hold the Budget Workshop Meeting scheduled for January 10, 2022 with the ZOOM component to enable the public to participate.
