Chairman Madigan announced this opportunity for the public to offer comments or raise questions. No one from the public had signed in to the meeting.

5. **COMMUNICATIONS:** None

6. REPORT FROM CHIEF ARCARI:

• Chief Arcari reported the Department responded to 68 calls during the month of December.

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• Chief Arcari noted the Purchase Agreement for the new vehicle has been signed by the Town of East Windsor and returned to Seagraves; total cost of the replacement vehicle is \$1,049.658.00. The pre-construction meeting is anticipated to be scheduled for the second week in February, at which time representatives from the Fire Department will approve the drawings and specs for the new truck. Delivery of the truck will occur 480 days after construction begins; the first payment is due the day the truck is delivered. Funding for the truck comes from the CIP (Capital Improvement Planning) section of the Town of East Windsor Broad Brook Fire Department Budget.

Chief indicated the Department is considering three payments options:

- 3 years at 2.78% interest for annual payments of \$214,172,67
- 5 year at 2.82% interest for annual payments of \$132,498.53
- 7 years at 2.93% interest for annual payments of \$97,724.72

Discussion followed regarding the funding options. Vice Chairman Macsata questioned if there's a total financial charge associated with each option? Chief Arcari suggested the Department is considering option 2 and 3, finance charges associated with option 2 is \$62,492 while finance charges associated with option 3 is \$82,219. Vice Chairman Macsata suggested it makes good financial sense to consider the 7 year payment option.

Chief Arcari noted the Department will need to purchase approximately \$100,000 in equipment to outfit the truck as well.

Discussion followed regarding possible adjustments. Chairman Madigan called for a motion to approve as proposed.
