There were a lot of inspections, they will begin the 5th roof after the holiday, the site financial audit has been completed satisfactorily, Jon Ference spent a lot of time at the Mill St/Main St paving project; it came out nicely, and they are planning for the Industrial Park upgrade for about a month from now. There has been quite a bit of load shedding this past month in hopes of reducing the electrical demand charge. The nitrogen credit has been received. The generator at Mill Pond will be replaced. Mr. Enderle explained the pictures in the Superintendent's Report. Mr. Anderson pointed out that Steve Bednarz Jr. has again made the President's List at Manchester Community College. Mr. Enderle reported that Katherine Kneeland received her Class II Operator Certificate and has passed her Operator III exam.
